- 1st, 3rd, 5th weekends from 6 p.m. Friday to 6 p.m. Sunday, and every Thursday during school year from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. (SPO)
- 1st, 3rd, 5th weekends from Friday school dismissal until Monday school arrival (E-SPO)
- Every Thursday night during school, beginning when school is dismissed and ending next morning when school resumes (E-SPO)
- Thanksgiving holiday: Non-custodial parent has possession during odd-numbered years, beginning when child is dismissed from school before Thanksgiving holiday and ending at 6 p.m. following Sunday
- Christmas holiday: Divided into two parts. In even-numbered years, non-custodial parent has child for first half of holiday, from day school dismissed until noon Dec. 26 (SPO) or noon Dec. 28 (E-SPO)
